

## Special Message to Scottsdale Area Association of REALTORS® Members

### Subject: 2018 SAAR® Candidate Review and Endorsements

Dear Member,

It is that time again for the municipalities of Scottsdale, Fountain Hills, Cave Creek and Carefree to hold their elections for City/Town Council.

As part of the advocacy initiatives laid forth in our [Strategic Plan](#), the Scottsdale Area Association of REALTORS® (SAAR) recommends and endorses candidates that recognize the issues facing our more than 9,000 members and share our vision for future communities that support real estate and homeownership.

Recently, a balanced, hard-working group of 14 of your peers reached out to the 33 candidates running for office and reviewed all 18 of the candidates who had responded to our invite to interview (*5 in Scottsdale; 5 in Fountain Hills; 6 in Cave Creek; and 2 in Carefree*). Our policy requires that candidates must fill out our candidate questionnaire in order to be considered for an interview and endorsement. In addition to assessing the viability of each candidate's campaign, they are evaluated based on their knowledge and understanding of the needs of their communities and the goals and direction they intend to pursue once in office, in relation to their support of real estate-specific issues as set forth in SAAR's [Policy Platform](#), which was adopted by your Board of Directors in 2012.

The 2018 SAAR Candidate Review Committee recommended, and the SAAR Board of Directors has approved, the endorsement of the following candidates:
